


## OUTREACH PROGRAM

Hope Center conducts a weekly outreach program in Northampton County with the hope of connecting with the underserved population who live with the disease of addiction. We offer moral support & provide resources for recovery as we engage with individuals on the streets. We try to establish relationships & build trust in order to bring awareness to treatment options & connect them with the support they need.

## RECOVERY-BASED PROGRAMS

### PAIR

**Police Assisting in Recovery** is aimed at helping local law enforcement in supporting individuals who are living with SUD by connecting them to recovery resources.

### CATCH

**Combatting Addiction Through Connections & Healing** is designed to create a pro-social approach in Northampton County Hospitals with a warm handoff process by connecting individuals to treatment & recovery support services with compassion & empathy.

### HERO

**Housing Emergency Response to Opioid & Stimulant Use Disorder** provides recovery & case management services that includes eliminating barriers to treatment & housing.

### RISE

**Recovery Interim Services & Empowerment** is designed to connect those incarcerated in Northampton County Prison with a Certified Recovery Specialist.

### TCAP

**Treatment Continuum Alternative to Prison** is a restorative diversionary program that offers recovery based services to eligible incarcerated persons. A Certified Recovery Specialist with personal & professional experience will provide individual recovery support.
