Have you seen it yet?!

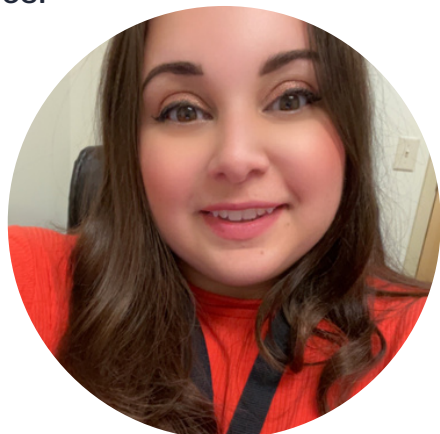
On Friday, August 25th, we celebrated 50 Years of service in our community! If you haven't yet, watch the video below to look back on the evening.
